

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Liverpool City Council (ABN 84 181 182 471) is the promoter (**Promoter**) of the Share your views on Liverpool, Win one (1) of three (3) EFTPOS Gift Cards Survey (**Competition**) whose registered office is at 50 Scott Street, Liverpool NSW 2170.
2. The Competition is a game of chance. At the date specified in determining the winners, each valid entry will be entered into a process of random selection. There is no cost or fee to enter the Competition
3. The Competition is being run through the Promoter's website, and a QR code which will be available on promotional collateral. The Competition may also be run through the Promoter's social media platforms, including Instagram, Facebook and LinkedIn. This Competition is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered by or associated with Instagram, Facebook or LinkedIn.
4. Employees of the Promoter and agencies associated with the Competition are ineligible to enter the Competition, as are their immediate families. Immediate families include parents, siblings, spouses and children.
5. To enter, each entrant must complete the survey for their chance to win one (1) of three (3) EFTPOS gift cards, valued at \$100 each (**Prize**).
6. Entrants must provide their full name, email or phone number and (if required), their postcode to validate the entry. One entry is permitted per person. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries. If the requested information is not provided, the entrant will not be eligible to participate in the Competition or to claim a Prize and their entry may be discarded.
7. Each entrant must be 16 years and over and an Australian resident who resides in the Liverpool LGA.
8. The Promoter will manage the personal contact information received through the Competition process in accordance with Council's Privacy Policy. Contact information will only be used for the purposes of conducting the Competition and it will not be provided to any third party, except as required by law.
9. Survey information gathered will be used by Council for research purposes.
10. Three (3) winners will be randomly selected at 5pm on 18 November 2024.
11. Winners will be contacted via email or phone before 22 November 2024. Winners are to respond to the Promoter within one (1) week of notification to arrange delivery of the Prize. Failure to do so will result in disqualification and forfeiture of any Prize.
12. The Promoter reserves the right to withdraw or amend the Competition and these terms and conditions with or without notice. Any changes to the Competition will be notified to entrants as soon as reasonably practicable by the Promoter.
13. By entering the Competition, an entrant is indicating their agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions. Further, the entrant releases the Promoter from and against any and all claims, demands, liability, damages or causes of action (howsoever arising), losses (including consequential loss), costs or expenses, with respect to or

arising out of or related to the entrant's participation in the Competition, acceptance of a Prize and/or use or misuse of a Prize (including, without any limitation, any property loss, damage, personal injury or death caused to any person(s)), any defect or malfunction or non-operation of a Prize and any infringement by the entrant of any intellectual property rights of any other person.

14. The Promoter is not liable or responsible for any defect, malfunction or non-operation of a Prize, and the entrant cannot make a claim for compensation, demand a refund or replacement of the Prize. The entrant must refer to the Prize's distributor.
